

Call for Papers to the 5th Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics June 14-15, 2010 in Reykjavik

The fifth annual Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics will take place at Reykjavik University. The accommodation will be at Hotel Loftleidir, about 200 meters from the university.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the best labor scholars in the Nordic countries to get together and to discuss their work. The meeting will contain both contributed and invited papers. The keynote speaker is Professor Philip Oreopoulos, University of Toronto.

The meeting is organized by ELE and Reykjavik University. ELE is a Nordic Center of Excellence: "Empirical Labor Economics", funded by The Joint Committee for Nordic Research Councils for the Humanities and Social Sciences (NOS-HS). This center is a joint effort of four national research groups based in Aarhus, Bergen, Uppsala and Helsinki.

The meeting will last for two days starting in the morning of June 14 and ending in the afternoon on June 15. The organizers will cover travel costs and accommodation from June 13 to June 16. The number of participants is limited to 40, and we expect to have about 15 contributed papers.

Papers submitted to the meeting should be sent to anette.olsson@ifau.uu.se by **March 29**. The organizers will evaluate all submitted papers and communicate the acceptance decisions by April 14.

Presenters of accepted papers and other persons wishing to attend should **register by May 5** by sending an email to anette.olsson@ifau.uu.se. Please include your name, address, whether you require a hotel accommodation and whether you have any special dietary requirements.
